Bedford (formerly Cumberland) County containing 200 acs. & allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by Dr. Wm. A. McKroy for Conrad Claycomb - being part of a tract that originally contained 534 3/4 acres and allowance. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Thomas Smith dated the 3rd of June 1763\* Examined, copied & returned the 25th of November 1851.
