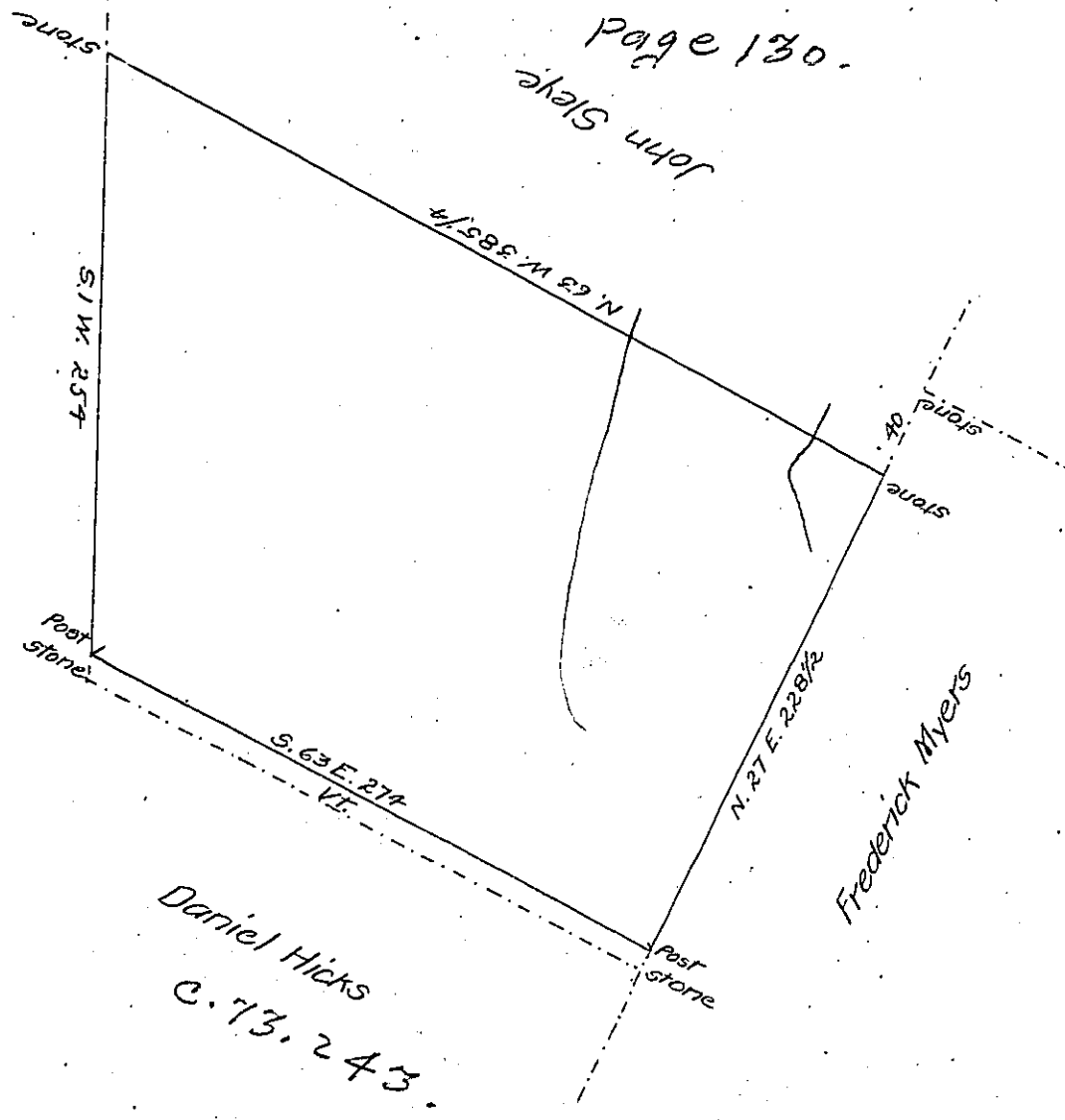

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 29th day of January 1793 Granted
 to Christian Stoner and order of Survey Recd. the 13th day of August 1845.
 Surveyed the 26th day of November 1845 the above described tract of Land
 Situate in the Township of Lackawaxen adjoining Land ~~Granted~~ to Frederick
 Myers. (formerly Northampton), now Pike County Containing four hundred forty
 three acres one hundred thirty Seven perches and allowance of six pct. for
 Roads &c.
