 Six per Cent for Roads &c. Being part of a Larger Tract of three hundred  
 and Thirty Six Acres and one hundred and twenty perches Surveyed  
 formerly for Peter Shiras on Warrant Dated the 7th. February 1765. And  
 the Above Division Surveyed and Laid off for John Horn the 23rd Day of  
 November A.D. 1822.
