



Draft of a tract of land Situate in Juniata Township Perry
 County Containing One hundred and three Acres Sixty eight ^{nine} perches and
 allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c Surveyed for John Clouser the
 Owner February 28th 1835

The upper portion of the above tract containing 72 as 42 ps & allowan- is
 part of 240 as 72 ps & ca surveyed in pursuance of an application No. 4235 dated
 27 July 1767 granted to Patrick Lanigan. An official survey of the said 72 as 42 ps was
 returned by Mr. Wm. Wilson then D.S. and accepted on the 12 August 1839, and is now
 on file in the Land office.

The lower portion of the above survey, containing 31 as 27 ps & ca is part of
 346 as 107 ps which was accepted in the Land office in pursuance of an order of the
 Board of Property dated 4 Feby. 1817, although no Warrant or Location could be found that
 exactly corresponded with the survey of 346 as 107 ps

Mr. Wilson says that he forwarded to the land office a separate survey of the
 31 as 27 ps at the same time that he sent the draft of 72 as 42 ps; but as that separate
 survey cannot now be found, the above draft is accepted in order that a patent may issue
 thereon.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in
 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
 February 1833, I have hereunto set my hand and caused
 the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,
 this twenty second day of January 1907
