Stuckey the 22nd of May 1841 who previous to and at the time owned the same by virtue of an improvement: resurveyed the 8th of December 1851, in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of said Samuel S. Stuckey for 172 acrs & 65 perches, dated the 3rd of December 1851, per Michael Reed
