



Situate about one mile above the mouth of Clearfield Creek on the north side of the West branch of Sisquahana (formerly Northumberland) now Clearfield County, containing four hundred & forty acres & the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads Surveyed the 28th day of December 1794. In pursuance of a Warrant No. 5606 Dated April the 2d day 1794.
