



N.B. there is a Warrant in the Names of Bernard Dougherty Esq and David Irwin dated Sept: 15th 1784 and David Irwin Applied, Executed on a Tract of Land claimed by James Hutchinson but after the above described Land was surveyed to Catherine Smith he then claimed it by the Same Warrant but as Mr Irwin claimed Hutchinson Land first I thought proper to make the Return to Catherine Smith and if the Surveyor Genl or Board of Property give any further Orders they shall be carefully attended to by
