



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Salford Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania. Containing Two hundred and fifty One Acres Strict Measure or Two hundred and Thirty Six Acres and 12 1/2 Perches of Land Together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads, Being the full half Part of a Tract of 500 Acres. That was formerly Surveyed To Francis Ganderwit in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 10th of the 4th Month 1717. Which Said Tract of Land was afterwards divided for William Walton and David Walton. Now Resurveyed on the 5th March Anno-1774 By Virtue of a Warrant of Resurvey Dated on the 3^d March Last past for the Said David Walton. By Order of the Surveyor General.
