



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July following on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Ninety One Containing in Breadth North and South on Fawn Street Sixty feet and in Length East & West Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Westward by Fawn Street aforesaid, Northward by Lot Number One hundred and Ninety, Eastward by Meadow Alley and Southward by Lot Number One hundred and Ninety Two. Returned into the Secretary's office the 16th day of December 1774 for John Wall by Warrant dated the 15th day of December Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighteenth day of March 1907.
