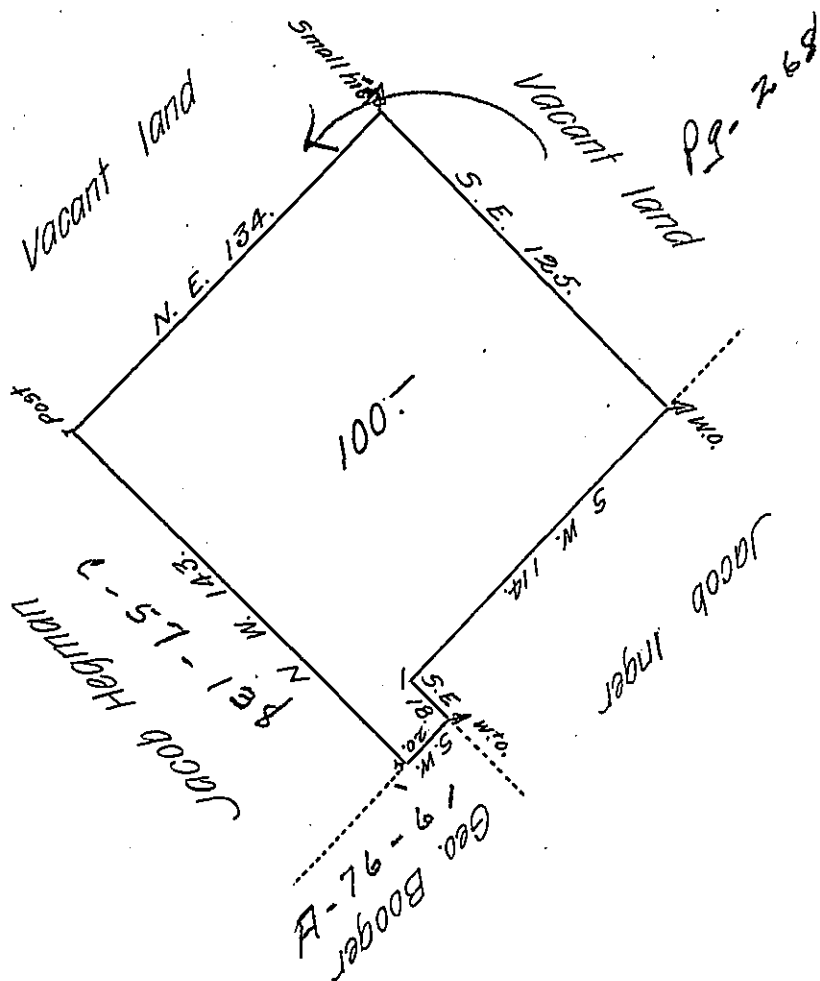

Surveyed on the Twelfth day of Feb<sup>r</sup>. 1733 to George Clouser a Tract of Land Situate In the Township of Salford in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. Beginning at a Small white Oak a Corner of George Boogers land thence by y<sup>e</sup> Same South West Twenty perches to a post a Corner of Jacob Hegmans land thence by y<sup>e</sup> Same North West one hundred & forty Three Another Corner of said Hegmans land thence by Va- cant land North East one hundred & thirty four perches to a Small Hickry Sap- ling Markt for a Corner Thence by Vacant land South East one hundred & Twen- ty five perches to a White Oak in y<sup>e</sup> line of Jacob Ingers land Thence by the Same South West one hundred & fourteen perches to a post a Corner of s<sup>d</sup> Ingers land Thence by the Same South East Eighteen perches to y<sup>e</sup> place of Begining Containing One Hundred Acres with Usual Allowance. Warrant dated the 8<sup>th</sup> January 1734.
