



Draught of Thirty Acres and 55 perches of Land with six per cent situate in Tuscarora Township Juniata county Resurveyed April 11th & 13th. 1844 by virtue of an order of resurvey Issued from the board of Land property bearing Date April 1st. 1844- granted to Thomas Sweringen
 Issued in consequence of a warrant granted to Thomas Sweringen dated 9th Jan^y. 1829 for Thirty Acres of Land, which said warrant was executed 2nd. Sept^r. 1829 and included ^{same} Land that was included in a survey made 17th May 1793 on warrant to James Beale dated 19th April 1786 containing 178[±] 22⁷/₁₆ Resurveyed as above stated by the authority aforesaid.

Note - The above is nearly all unimproved and there was a warrant granted to Joshua Beale for 20 Acres of the Land along the south of the above survey & within said Lines Dated 26th Feb^r. 1842 and I went and marked same for the Lines and said Beale told me he would not have it Laid on then; since which time he has never called on me to execute said warrant and I am informed that he has said I never should lay it on.
