



The above draught represents a survey made Nov 13th A.D. 1832 for Matthew Stewart for the Heirs of James Stewart deceas'd upon an actual ^{settlement} and improvement containing two hundred and eighty three acres and the allowance of six per cent which I return in pursuance of a warrant dated the 8th day of May A.D. 1833 for 283 acres adjoining lands of Robert Young on the South and others as above situate in the township of Cherango Beaver County
