



Situate in Frankstown township Huntingdon County containing nine acres 62 perches <sup>0.61</sup> allowance the same being part of a tract of land originally surveyed the 28<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. 1814 in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Smith dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Agt. 1814. The original survey was said to contain 50<sup>ac</sup> 65 perches & allowance. This part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August 1834.
