



Situate in Frankestown Township Huntingdon County containing two hundred sixty six acres 9 perches & the usual allowance the same being part of a tract of land originally surveyed in pursuance of an order of survey granted to John Proctor dated 1<sup>st</sup> of August 1766 said survey was then said to contain 305 1/4 this part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Sept. A.D. 1831.
