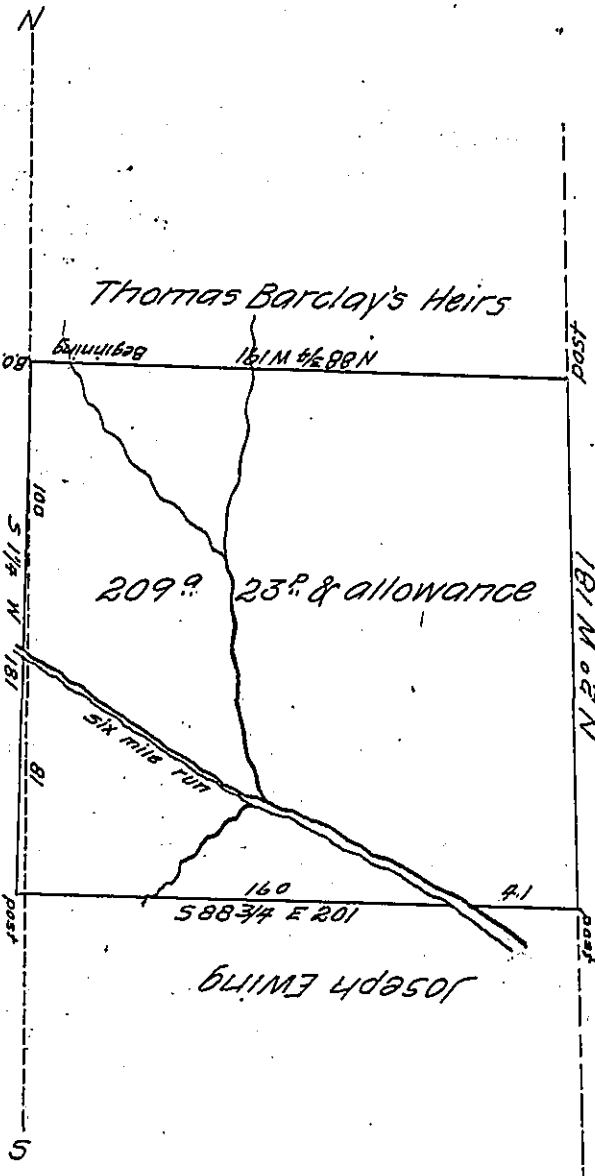

The above draught represents a tract of land surveyed October 6<sup>th</sup> A. D. 1836 for Philip Sientz on a settlement and improvement situate in Ohio Township Beaver County Pa. adjoining lands of Joseph Ewing on the south George Seabring on the west Thomas Barclay's Heirs on the north and McClairs district on the east containing 209 acres 23 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
