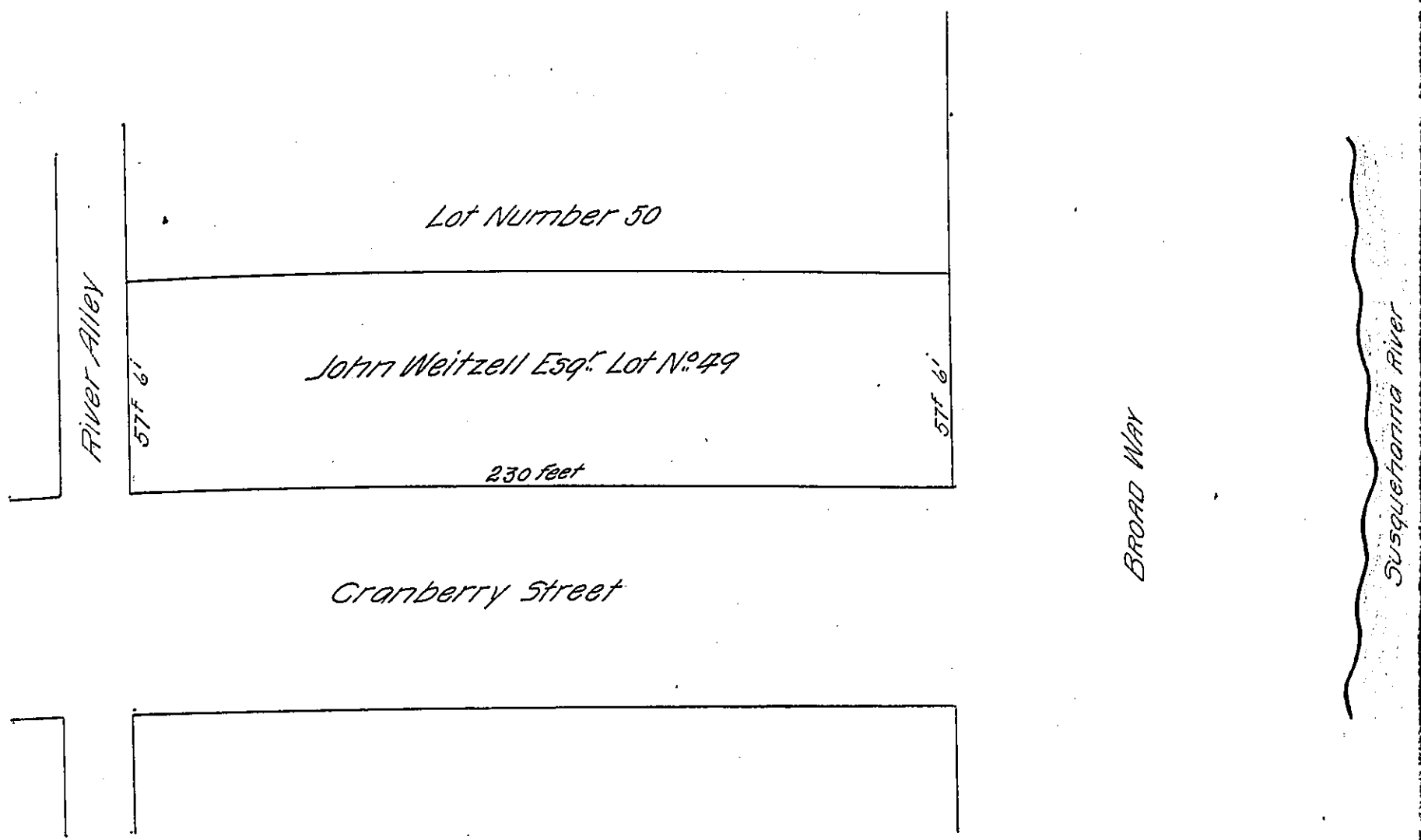

In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 on a certain lot of ground situate in the town of Sumbury in the County of Northampton marked in a general plan of said town number forty nine containing in breadth north and south on Broad Way fifty seven feet six inches and in length east and west two hundred and thirty feet bounded westward by Broad Way southward by lot number fifty eastward by River Alley and Northward by Cranberry Street returned to the Secretary's Office the 27th day of June 1776

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eleventh day of March 1907
