



A draught of a tract of land called the half Moon situate on the south side of the west branch of Susquehanna — about eleven miles below the mouth of Clearfield Creek in the County of Bedford ^{in the warrant called Northumberland} containing two hundred & fourteen acres & the usual allowance of six P cent for roads &c surveyed the 24th day of May 1776 for John Wilson in pursuance of a warrant dated the twelfth day of May 1773.
