



Pursuant to a warrant from the Proprietaries bearing date the 31st day of July 1776 survey'd the lesser of the above tracts of land unto Andrew Weil situate in Springfield Township Bucks County according to the above plan of the same containing thirty two acres & forty five perches of land and allowance of six acres P. cent being all the land which appears to be there vacant survey'd by order of John Lukens Surveyor General the 11th day of ye 10th month 1776

Note - - The larger of the above tracts containing fifty acres & three quarters & allowance of six acres P. cent seems to have been some way taken up tho' not confirm'd has been improv'd & the improvements purchased by Michael Shyer who is now in possession of it and at his request the same was survey'd at the same with the other and a draught thereof made as above.
