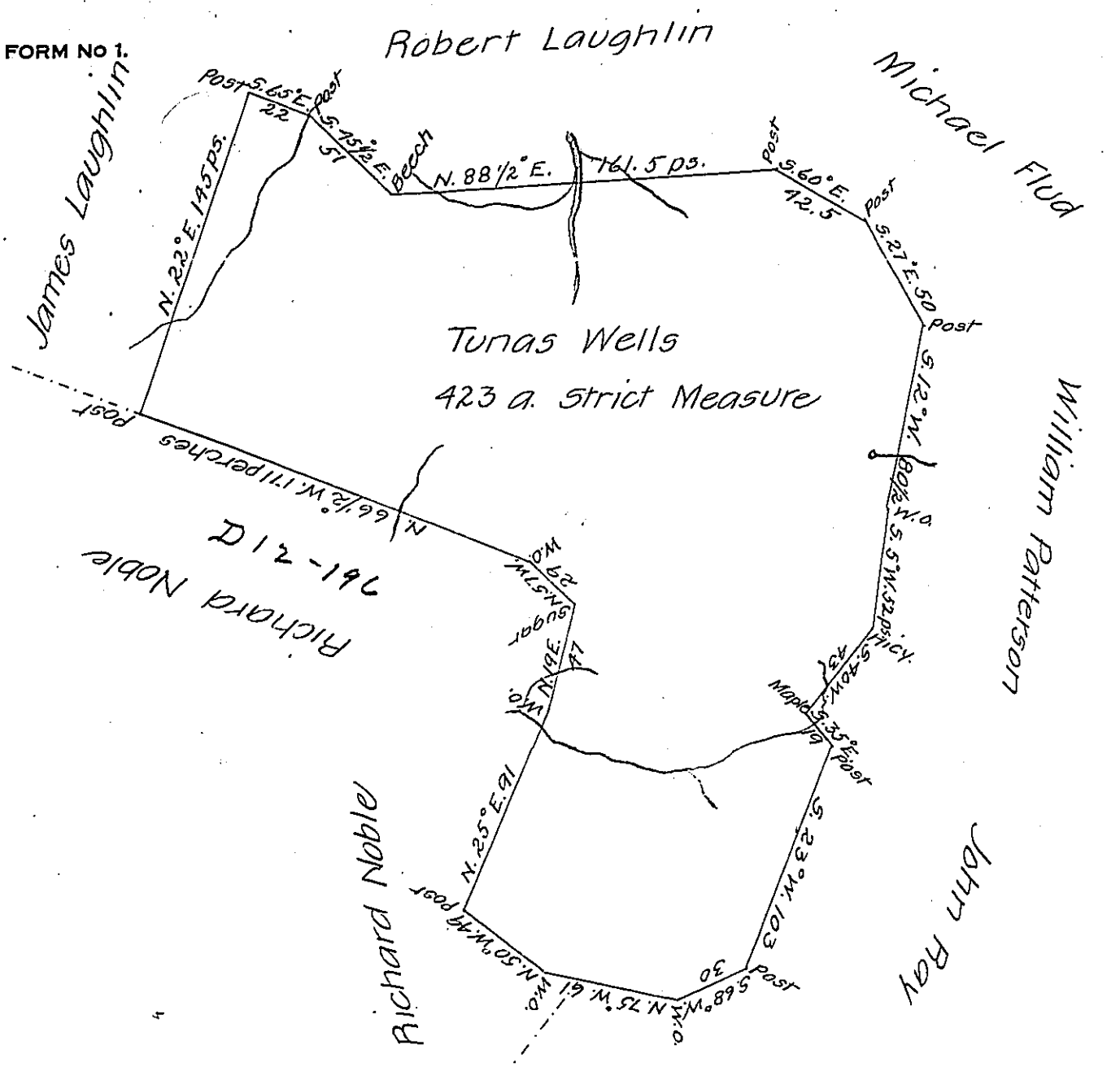


FORM NO 1.



Situate in Washington Township on the waters of Big Redstone Creek in the County of Fayette and surveyed February 4th 1785. In pursuance of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners &c. of which the following is a true copy. We the Commissioners appointed for Adjusting the Claims to unpatented lands in the counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Tunas Wells is intitled to four hundred acres of land in the County of Yohogania on the waters of Redstone—to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and seventy two. Given under our hands at Redstone old Fort the Eighteenth day of December 1779 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
