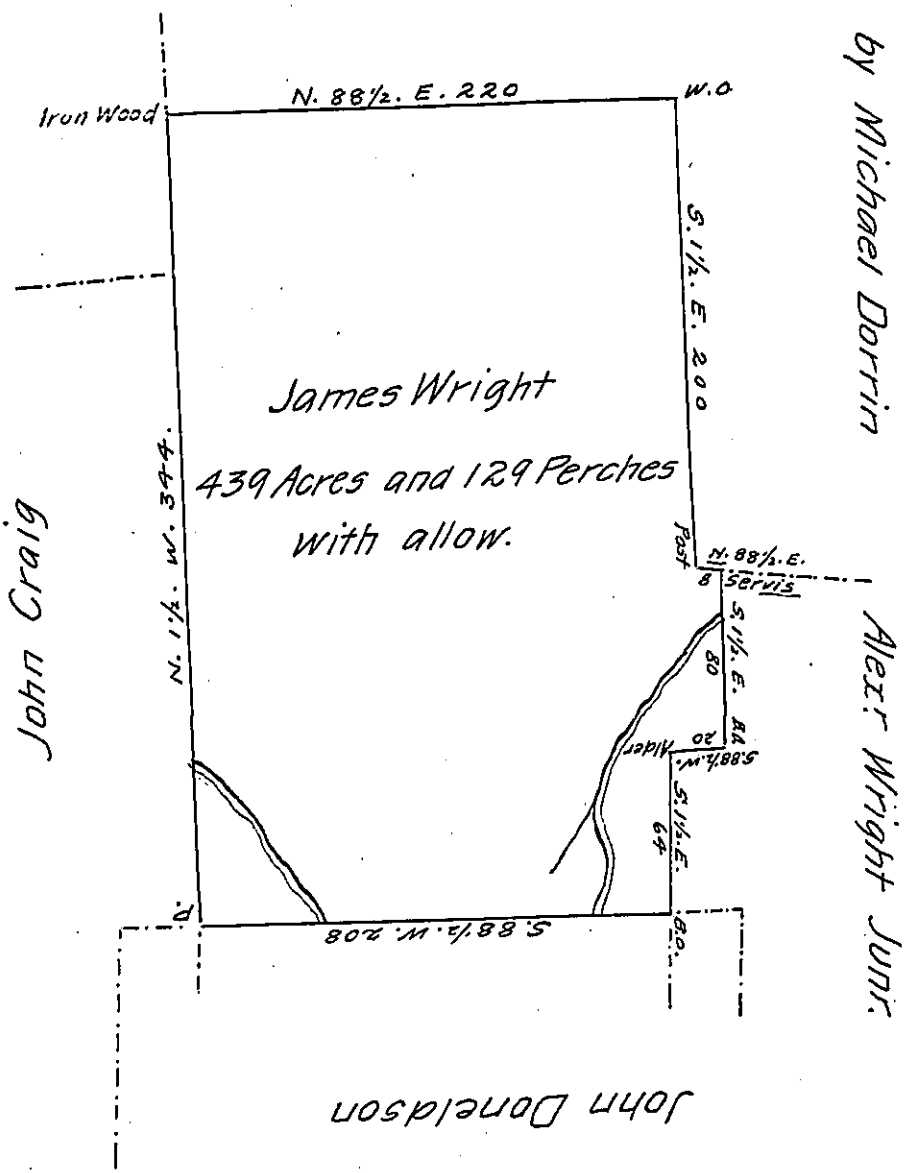


Land Setled and Claimed
