



Surveyed to Aaron Wer on the 12th. day of Novr. 1813 the above described tract of land containing Two hundred and Fourteen Acres and One hundred & five Perches with an allowance of Six per Cent &c. it being in pursuance of a Warrant dated January 10th. 1794, Situate N.W. of the Allegeny river on Buffaloe Creek about four miles up said Creek from its Mouth & adjoining lands of Archabald McCall & Nicholas Moyer & Others - that part which Includes the letter **A** is in Buffaloe Township Armstrong County that part which Includes the letter **B** is in Butler County - the Settlers Improvement and Buildings is in Armstrong County.
