



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the third day of May 1733 Survey'd unto John White of the City of Philad^a. Mercht the ninth of the same month a Tract of Land situate in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a White Oak being a Corner of Land Survey'd for the Proprietaries thence by the same North 80° East 255 perches to a post thence South 10° East 200 perches to a post - thence South 80° West 255 perches to a post thence North 10° West 200 perches to the place of Beginning. Containing Three hundred acres and the usual allowance for roads. —
