


FORM NO 1.



By Virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries dated the sixth day of May  
 1734 - Surveyed unto Catherine Widner a tract of land situate in Oley in the  
 County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. Beginning at a Corner stone thence by Vacant land North  
 Seventy degrees west One hundred and forty perches to a post thence by Vacan-  
 t Land South Twenty degrees west Twenty perches to a post thence North Seventy  
 degrees West Sixty four perches to a post thence North Twenty degrees East by Vacant  
 land One hundred and Eighty perches to a Black Oak thence by Vacant land South  
 Seventy degrees East Two hundred and four perches to a post thence by Vacant  
 Land South Twenty degrees west One hundred & Sixty perches to ye place of  
 Beginning Containing Two hundred acres with the usual allowance of six  
 p cent
