The Conditions of Simeon Woodrow's Warrt not being by him complied with his Survey became void & in pursu. of a Warrt dated the 20th of June 1740 to make a Return of the 176<sup>a</sup> for Isaac Woodrow the same with the 42<sup>a</sup> in one Descript<sup>n</sup>. Returned &c. y<sup>e</sup> 20th of June 1740
