N.B. This land was first surveyed to Joseph Brown by Warrant of the 24<sup>th</sup>  
 of April 1740 but he not complying &c<sup>o</sup> the survey was ordered  
 to be returned by Warrant of the 22<sup>d</sup> of December 1744 for the use  
 of Jacob Wismer Jun<sup>r</sup> and Joseph Wismer
