



Situate in Hamiltonban Township Adams County. Surveyed October 16th 1813. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Snively & Joseph Snively Junr. for 400^{1/2} dated August 20th 1813. Containing four hundred & twenty four acres & all. on which there was when I made the Survey a cobb in and a family living in it but how long they had resided in it I do not know.
