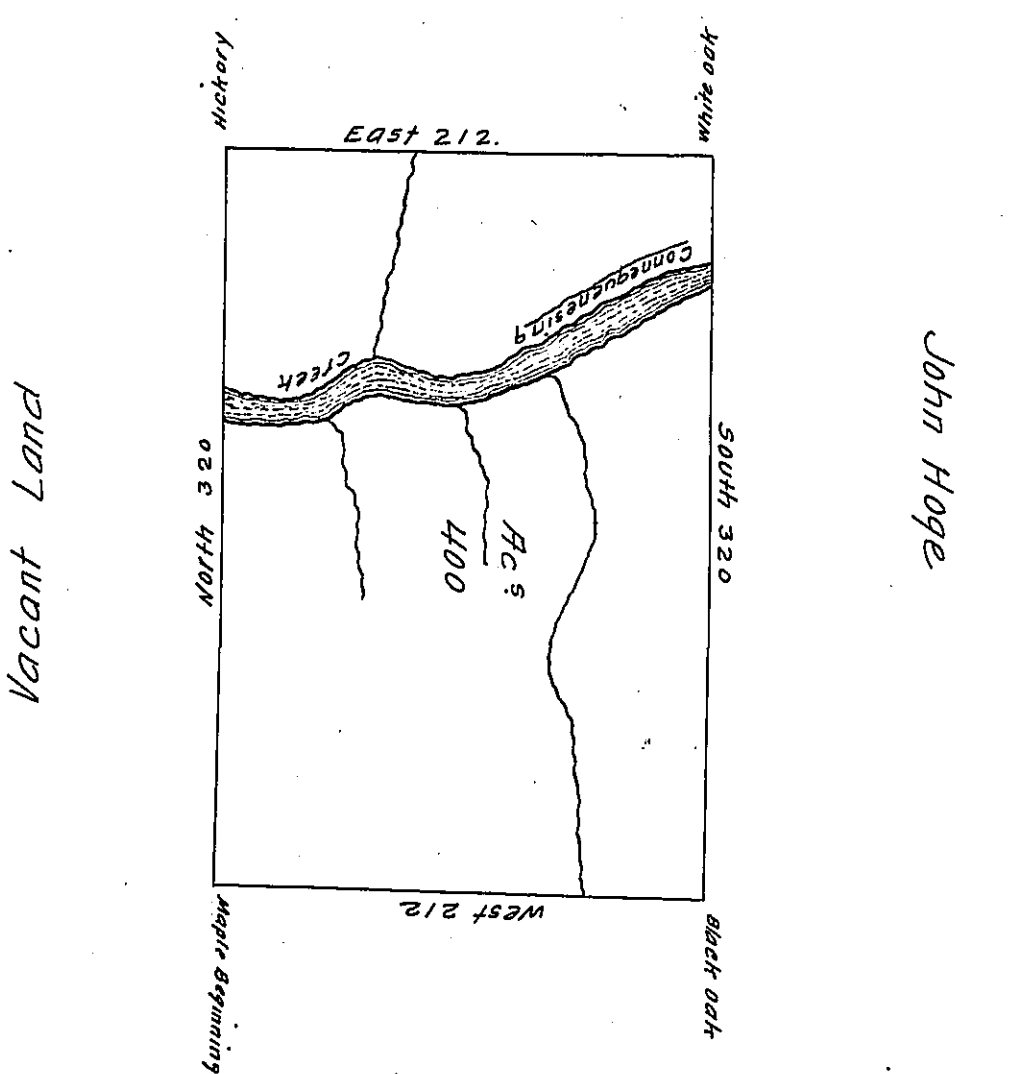


Trustees of Washington Academy

The above is a Draught of a Survey made Novemb^r 14th 1793. in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to the ~~West~~ Trustees of Washington Academy for 3,000 Acres of Land in Separate Tracts. Dated the 9th of August 1793. Situate North West ward of the Rivers Ohio and Allegheny. on Cannequenesing Creek in District N^o 10. Called Beaver Pond. (Adjoining a Tract of Land Surveyd for Said Trustees. Called Mount pleasant.) Containing four hundred Acres of Land together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^o Cent for Roads.
