The above is a Draught of a Survey made Novemb^r 15th 1793. in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to the ~~Washington~~ Trustees of Washington Academy for 3,000 Acres of Land in Separate Tracts. Dated the 9th Day of August 1793. Situate North Westward of the Rivers Ohio & Allegheny including the Mouth of the Connequenesing on Big Beaver Creek in District N^o 10 Called Morison's hunting Ground. (Adjoining a Tract of Land Surveyed for Said Trustees Called Beaver Pond.) Containing four hundred Acres together with the Usual Allowance of Six p^{ct} Cent for Roads.
