The part of Rodebergers claim within the dotted line and enclosed in Thompsons Survey contains 32 A. 88 p. 1/2 allowance of Six per cent &c.

The black line claimed by Thompson appears from the growths of the marked trees to have been run nineteen, and the dotted line claimed by the heirs of Rodeberger eighteen years ago. Which of those lines were made by consent of the parties or whether ^{either} of them I cannot say, the only improvement on the premiss claimed by the heirs of Rodeberger is a field cleared on the south east end of the tract.
