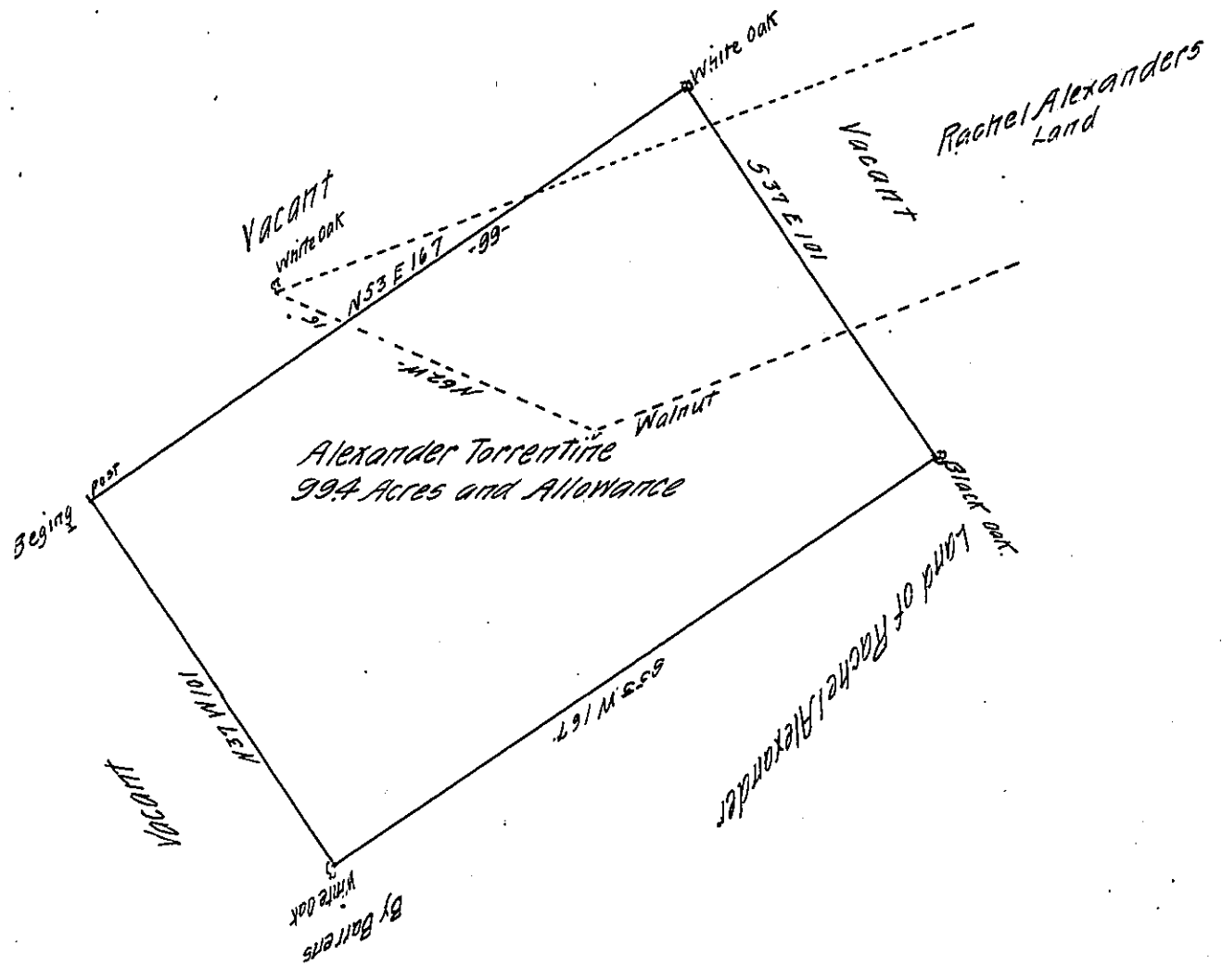


This intersects with a survey made & returned by John Armstrong Esq for Rachel Alexander as is represented by the dotted lines
