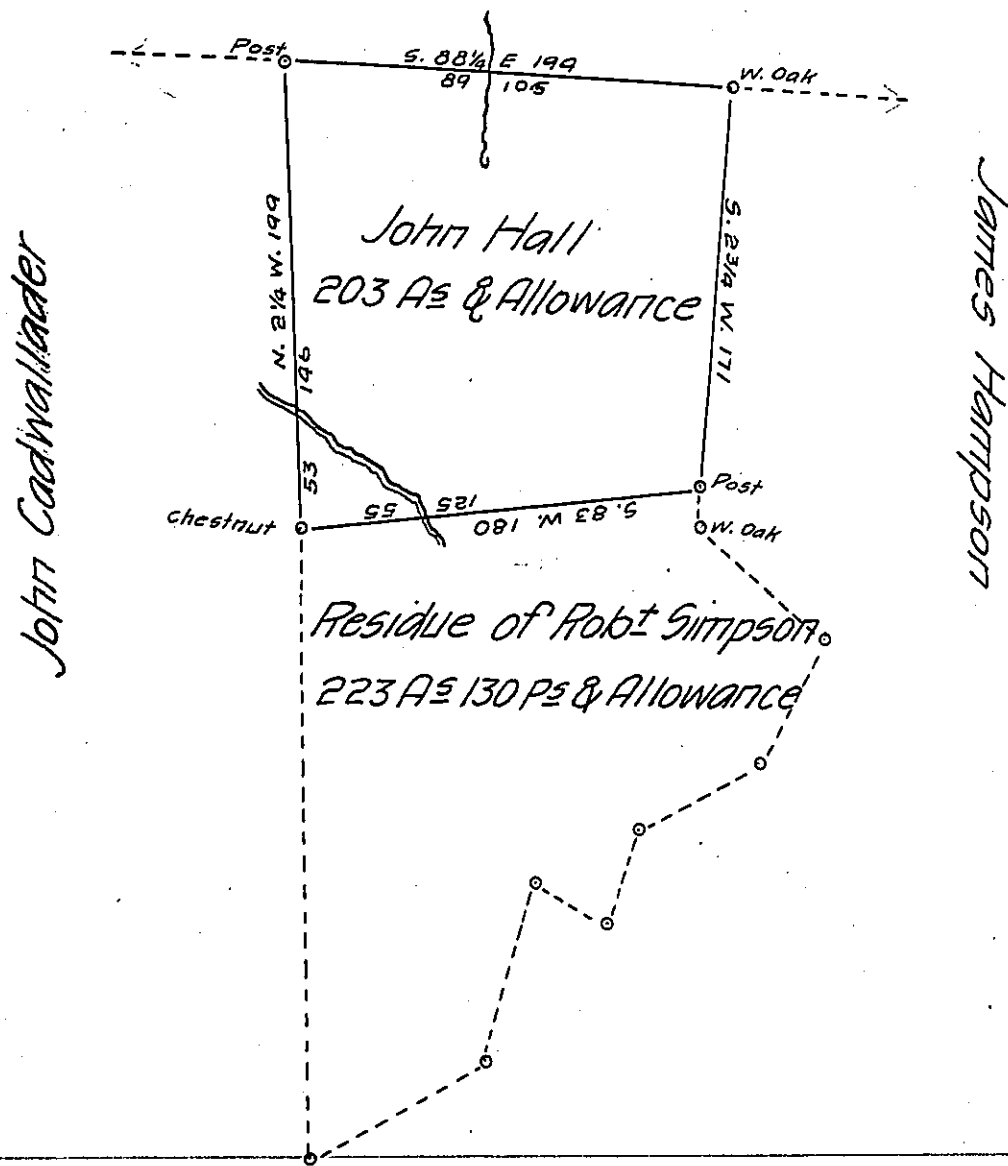

Being part of a tract of land first Surveyed the 1st day of Dec^r 1794 in pursuance of a W^t granted to Robert Simpson dated the 5th day of August 1794 the above resurveyed and divided from the residue of the tract the 18th day of May 1868 by request of John Hall who purchased it from John Smiley's Administrators
