



A Draught of a tract of land Situate in Manchester township in the County of York. Containing as above set forth 7as. & 106 perches & allowance, being part of a larger Tract of 214 1/4 as. and allowance, which was formerly surveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. on the 1th day of April A.D. 1789. In pursuance of a warrant for 200 as granted to Abraham Troastel bearing date the 3d day of June 1788. The above having been laid off from the said larger tract of land the 1st day of June Anno Domini 1810. And now on the sixteenth day of June 1812, the same has been calculated, examined and found to be correct, and at the request of the present owner the said Abraham Troastel returned for confirmation.
