



Situate in Springfield Township Huntingdon County (& in Black Log Valley including the junction of Black Log & Shade Creeks in the original survey) Containing ninety three acres 157 perches & allowance, the same being part of a tract of land originally surveyed in pursuance of ~~a~~ an application No. 3231 granted to Thomas Cluggage dated 27th March 1767. The original survey was said to contain 341 as 100 & allowance. This part resurveyed & divided from the original survey the 30th day of April 1834.
