



A Draught of a Survey called "the balance" situate on Peters Creek in Washington County containing 158 acs. strict Measures executed July the 6<sup>th</sup> 1786 in Pursuance of an Entry & Certift<sup>t</sup> granted to Josha<sup>a</sup> Wright by the Commissioners appointed by (obl) to adjust the Titles to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahela Yorkiog<sup>e</sup> & Ohio, which Certift<sup>t</sup> was duly entered with the County Survf. the return made for the Heirs of Josha<sup>a</sup> Wright from the Books of Nevill & Ritchie D. Srs.
