



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate partly in Marlborough, and partly in Upper Salford Townships in the County of — Montgomery, and State of Pennsylvania, Containing fifty three acres & one hundred and forty nine perches and the Allowance of six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for Roads &c. Which is part of a Tract of 1100 acres that was Originally Survey'd to Deitrick Welker in pursuance of a General Grant or Warrant from the late Proprietaries on or about the first day of March 1751, to the said Deitrick Welker, and was Resurveyed to him, by virtue of a Renewal of said General Grant dated the 11th day of June A.D. 1768. — Resurvey'd to Henry Kooker February the 9th 1808 $\frac{1}{2}$ Cadwd Foulke, for Nathan Potts D.S. Returned February 22nd 1808 $\frac{1}{2}$ Nathan Potts D.S.
