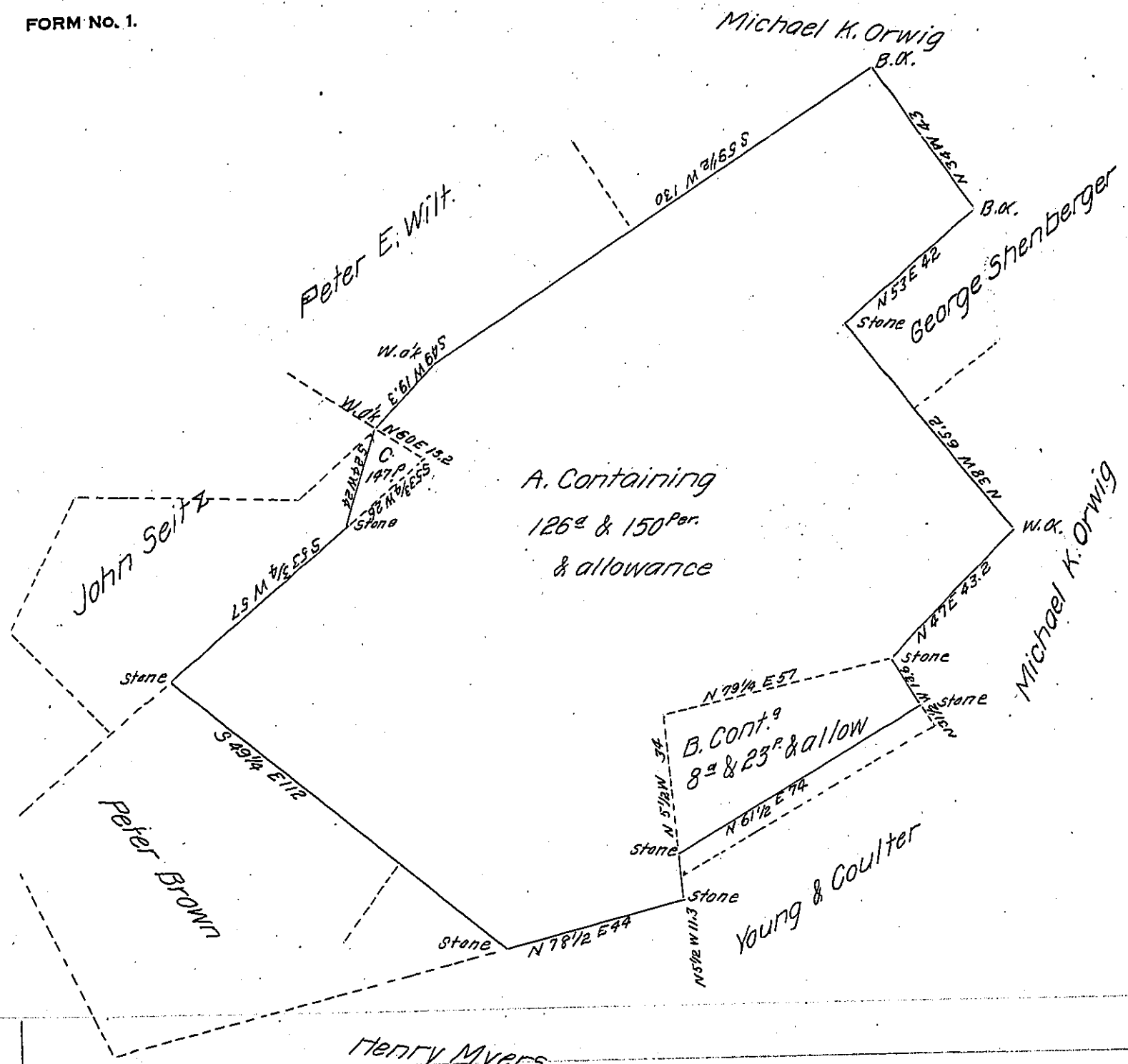


FORM NO. 1.



Situate in Springfield and Hopewell townships York County, Containing in all 136 Acres and allowance of six per cent. The part marked "A" was originally Surveyed for Herman Miller in pursuance of his application No. 2826, on the 6th of the 2^d mo. 1775, and contains 126^a & 150 perches and allow. The part marked "B" was surveyed the 17th day of Nov. 1803, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Herman Miller, dated June 30th 1803, and contains Eight acres and 23 perches & allowance. The part marked "C" was surveyed on the 17th & 18th days of Nov. 1803, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Herman Miller dated June 30th 1803, and contains 147 perches and allowance, Surveyed Aug. 30th A.D. 1864, for Jacob Venus & Israel Hartman present owners.
