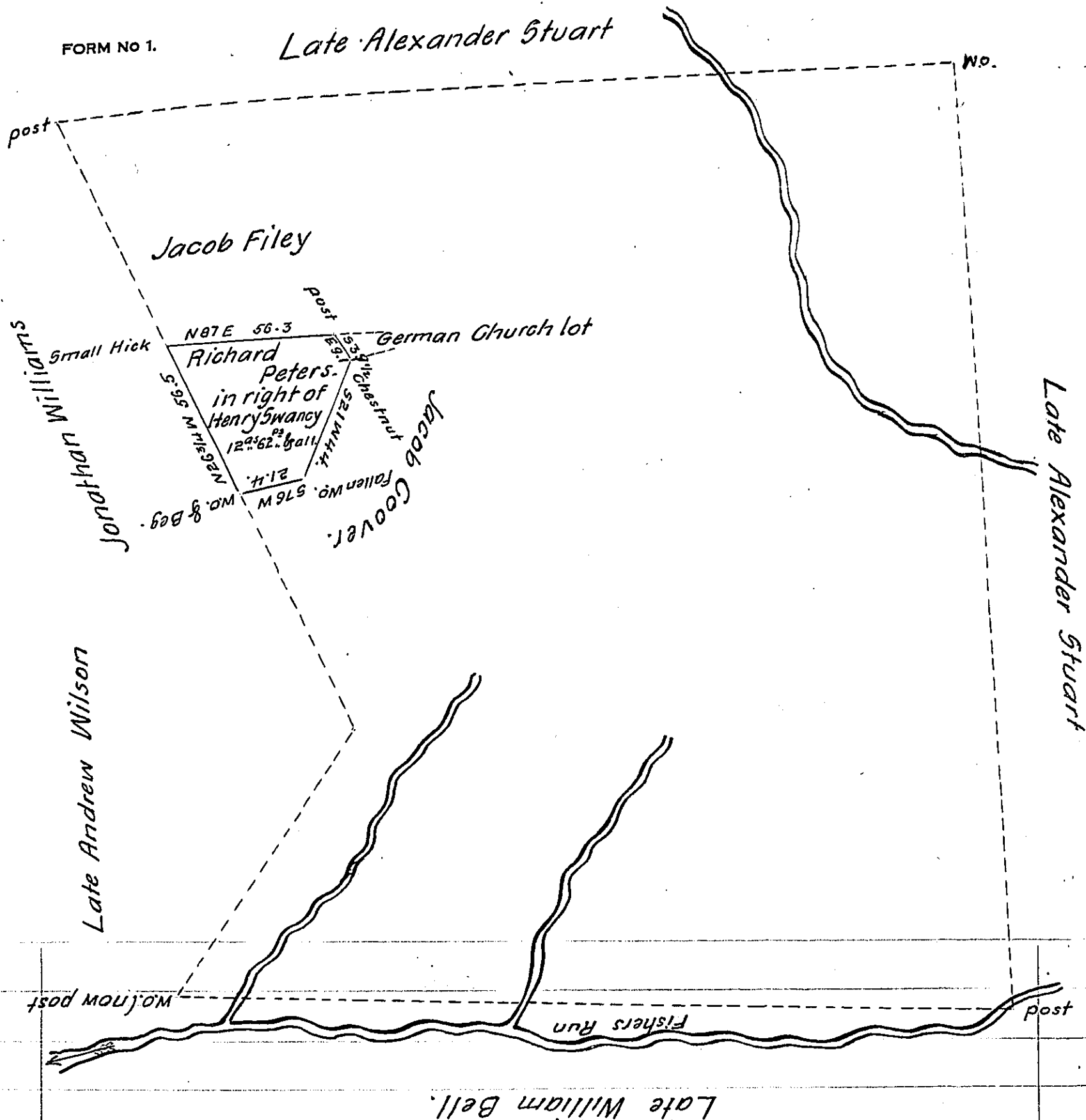


Late Alexander Stuart
