



Situate on Crosses Mill Run, a branch of Big Sandy Creek in Wharton township, Fayette County and surveyed the 25th day of September 1831 in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of John Tuttle for 200 acres of Land dated the 29th day of February 1820. At the time of the Surveying there was about 40 acres in a state of cultivation, a log house, and barn and a family residing on this tract, and appears as if the improvement might be now 20 years old.
