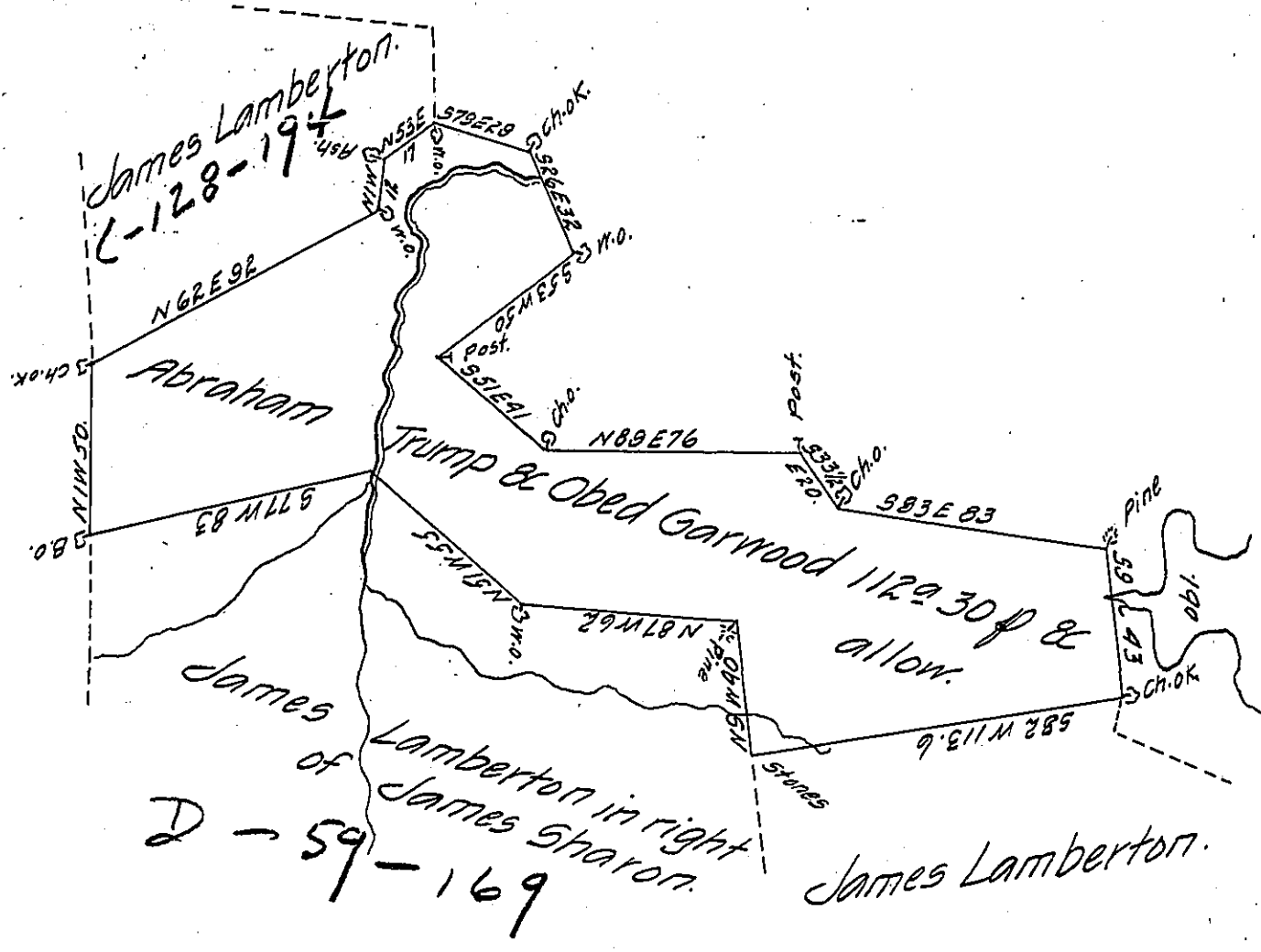


Andrew Lawshe in right of James Sharon.
