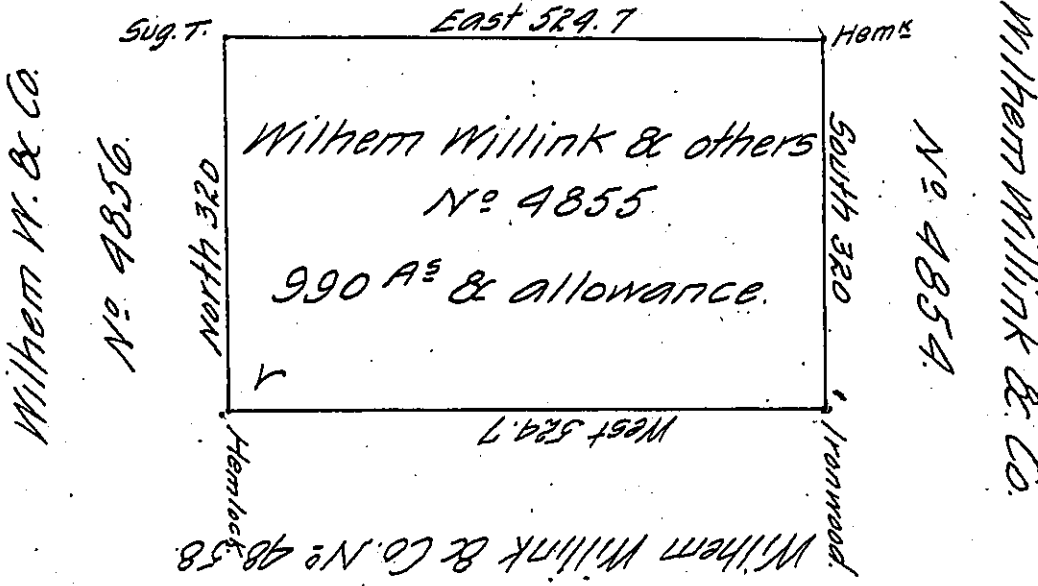


Wilhem Willink & others No 4848.

By Warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicholaas Vanstaphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollen Hooven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam No 4855. Dated the third day of February 1794 for 900 Acs
