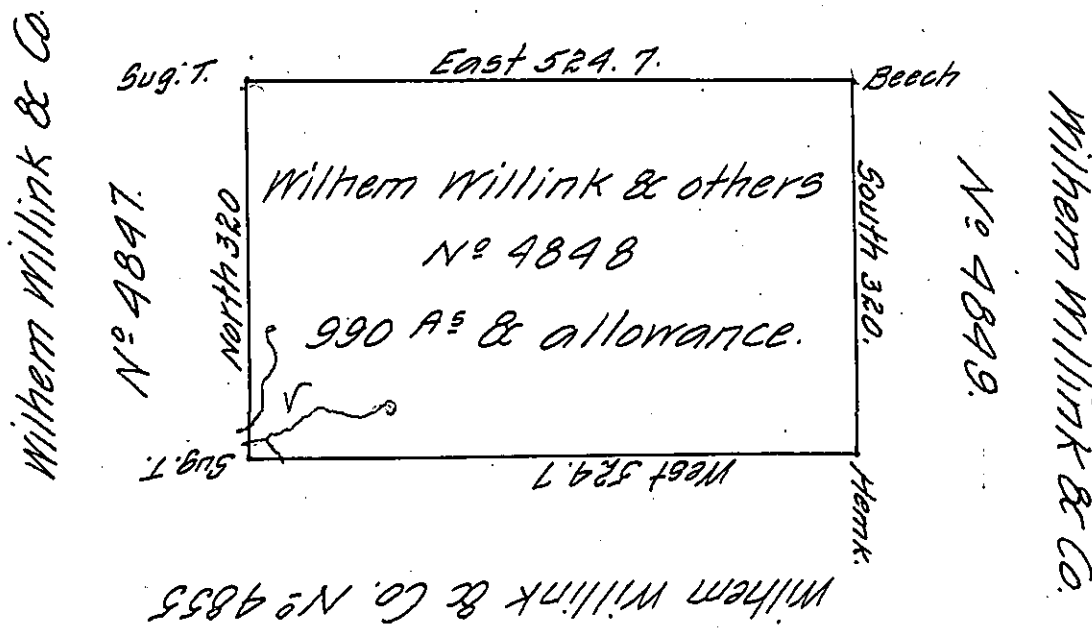


Herman Le Roy & Co. N<sup>o</sup> 3285

Situate on or near the head of the West Branch of Big Tobys Creek in the Last purchase District N<sup>o</sup> 4. Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety Acres & the usual allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c. Surveyed the Nineteenth day of July 1794. By Warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicholaas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam. Dated the third day of February 1794, for 900 Acres N<sup>o</sup> 4848.
