


Wilhem Willink & others N° 9849.



Situate in the fork of big Toby's Creek in the west side of District N° 9 in Last purchase Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety Acres & the usual allowance of Six pr. ct. for Roads &c. Surveyed the eighteenth day of ~~JULY~~ 1794. By Warrant to Wilhem Willink. Nicholaas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eghe Hendrick Vollen Hoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam N° 9854. Dated the third day of February 1794 for 900 Acres. Dr James Hunter D.S. To Daniel Brodhead Esq^r S.G.
