


Wilhem Willink & Co. No 9859

Surveyed the Seventeenth Day of July 1794 By warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Stophorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven & Puttger Jan Schimmel Penninck of Amsterdam No 9863. Dated the Third day of February 1794 for 900 Acres
