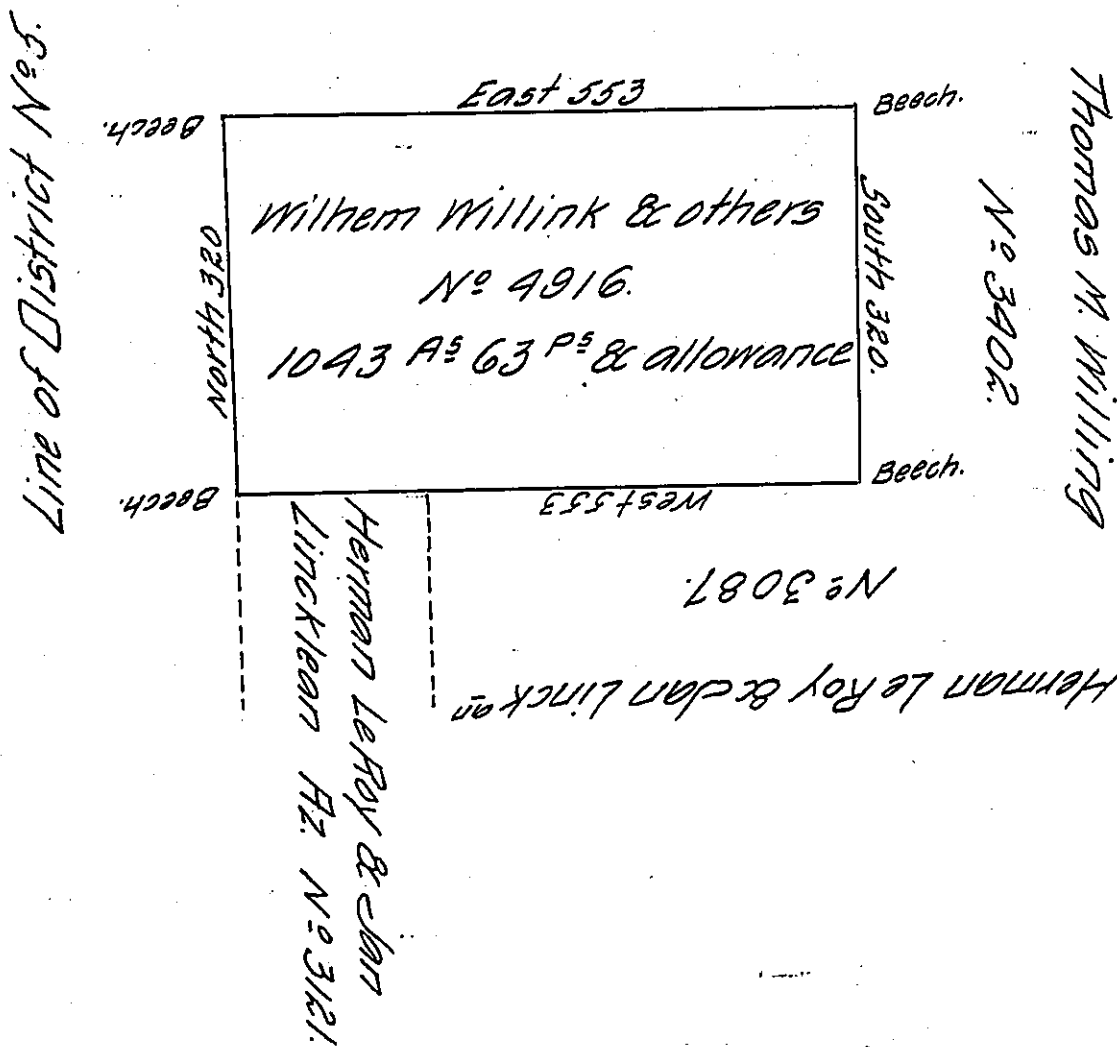


Wilhem Willink & others No 4915



Situate in the last purchase District No 9 joining the line of District No 5 fifteen Miles south of the line of York State containing One thousand & forty three Acres Sixty three perches & the usual allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c Surveyed the Twenty eighth day of July 1794. By Warrant to Wilhim Willink Nicholas Van Staphors (661) Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam No 4916. Dated the third day of February 1794 for 900 A's.
