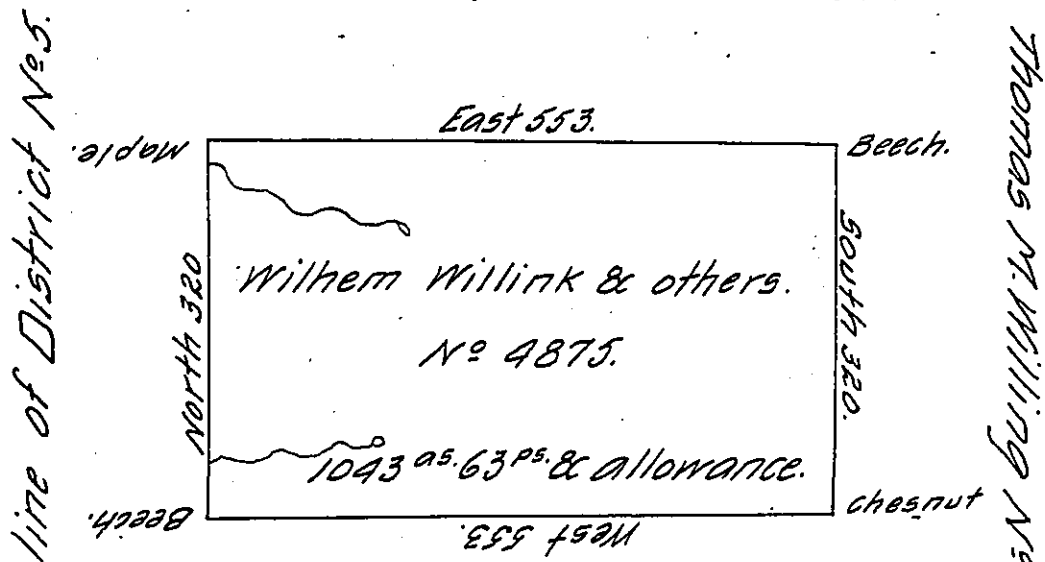

Nicholaas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam No 4875. Dated the third day of February 1794.
