By Warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Pieter Stadnitski Christiaan Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam No 4910. Dated the Third day of February 1794.
