Situate in District No 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River adjoining Wilhem Willink, and others No 2325; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam No 2446, dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
