



Surveyed on the twenty seventh Day of June 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per Cent situate in district N° 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River; adjoining Wilhem Willink and others N° 2709; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam N° 2710; dated the twelfth Day of December 1792.
