



Surveyed on the twenty seventh Day of June 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per cent Situate in District N<sup>o</sup> 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River adjoining Wilhem Willink, and others N<sup>o</sup> 2317; by virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinnick of Amsterdam N<sup>o</sup> 2321; dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
