



Surveyed on the 29th Day of June 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per Cent Situate in District N° 6 in the late Purchase on the East side of the Allegany River adjoining Wilhem Willink and others N° 2322; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam N° 2324; dated the twelfth Day of December 1792.
